CHoPS was initiated in Israel in 1995 and since then has grown to become an international event. It operates under the International Scientific Council (ISC) and will be hosted every three years by a different country. The previous CHoPS conferences were:

- 3rd – Dead Sea, Israel (2000)

ICBMH has been alternating on a 3-year cycle between the Universities of Newcastle and Wollongong since 1983. It is organised by the Australian Society for Bulk Solids Handling (ASBSH), which is a Technical Society of Engineers Australia.

BULKEX has been run in Australia since 1998 and is the largest bulk materials handling exhibition of its kind in the Asia-Pacific Region. The organisers of this event, Informa Australia, has agreed to run a special BULKEX in Brisbane in 2009 in conjunction with CHoPS and ICBMH.
